**LICENSE TRANSFER FROM ANOTHER STATE** – updated 6/1/2019

License transfer candidates must fill out their application on the NABP web site at [www.nabp.pharmacy](http://www.nabp.pharmacy). The NABP web site has a link for "Licensure Transfer." Fill out the Licensure Transfer Online Application.

Complete the **LA-01R License Application: Pharmacist by Transfer/Reciprocity** application. Take an [FD-258 Fingerprint Form](#) (printed on white cardstock) and the S-100 to a fingerprinting agency. If you are unable to print the FD-258, you can request one be sent to you using the form available on our website [www.pharmacy.ks.gov](http://www.pharmacy.ks.gov) >Licensing & Registration. Submit the completed LA-01R, fingerprint card, and S-100 completed by the fingerprinting agency. Attach a check or money order for \$172.00\* made payable to the Kansas Board of Pharmacy and send the application to the following address:

License transfer candidates will be required to take and pass the Kansas edition of the MPJE. To register for the Kansas MPJE go to the NABP web site at [www.nabp.pharmacy](http://www.nabp.pharmacy). Go to the link titled "MPJE" and start the exam registration. Select the jurisdiction of Kansas. Be sure to download the MPJE Registration bulletin which contains information about the exam.

Kansas Statutes & Regulations for study purposes can be found on the Kansas web site at [www.pharmacy.ks.gov](http://www.pharmacy.ks.gov) under the link titled "Statutes and Regulations". These can be downloaded.

Once you have applied for the Kansas edition of the MPJE and submitted your LA-01R, fingerprints, and payment, you will receive an Authorization to Test (ATT) number from NABP. The ATT number is used to schedule your MPJE with Pearson Vue. Pearson Vue locations and scheduling can be found on the NABP web page [www.PearsonVue.com/NABP](http://www.PearsonVue.com/NABP).

Results of the MPJE examination for candidates seeking licensure will be posted on the NABP Website. You can access your test results on the NABP website by logging in to your e-Profile. Scores are released to the boards anywhere between two to ten business days from the date the candidate sat for the exam. Scores will not be given out over the phone. If you do not pass the MPJE you must wait a minimum of 30 days to retake the examination.

## **CHECKLIST FOR LICENSE TRANSFER RECIPROCITY**

1. Go to the NABP web page at [www.nabp.pharmacy](http://www.nabp.pharmacy)
2. Go to the link for "Licensure Transfer" and fill out the online application.
3. Complete the LA-01R, fingerprints, and S-100 and send along with payment.
4. Mail the application to Kansas at:

**Make sure you attach a check for \$172.00 made payable to the Kansas Board of Pharmacy.**
5. On the NABP web site go to the link for "Examination."
6. Complete the application for Multistate Pharmacy Jurisprudence Exam (MPJE)
7. NABP will provide you with your ATT number.
8. Schedule to take the MPJE on the NABP web site ([www.nabp.pharmacy](http://www.nabp.pharmacy)).

**Note: Social Security Numbers are required in Kansas for purposes of child support enforcement and for the Department of Revenue. If your application does not have your Social Security Number, it can delay your license.**
